Executive Directive No. 21/2018

Sub:- Kerala Police – Imparting Basic Training to the Police personnel/Officers recruited under the Sports Quota -instructions issuing of - reg.

- Ref:- 1. This Office Order No.L7-32508/18 dt.09/04/2018.
2. Letter No.45/Camp/IGP(TR)/2018 Dated.18/04/18 of IGP(TR) and Central Sports Officer, Kerala Police.

The Inspector General of Police, Tvpm. Range & the Central Sports Officer, Kerala Police has submitted a proposal vide reference second cited for the amendment in the "basic police training" being given to the Police Officers/Personnel recruited under the Sports Quota, in Kerala Police. This is with a view to ensure that these personnel continue as good sportsman and the basic training does not adversely affect their performance in any manner, since these personnel are recruited for special purpose to compete in the State, National or International Sports and Games and bring laurels to the Dept., State as well as to the Country. It will be our endeavour to utilize their talents maximum up to the period when they are capable of participating in such competitions. The present practice of subjecting the sports personnel to the same "basic training" as the Police personnel recruited to Battalions, has many disadvantages. It adversely affects their performance in their respective sports events and also in many cases leads to injuries, which may ruin their sports career. To deal with this problem, the following directions are issued for the training of the newly recruited Sports personnel, in respect of their basic training.

1. Basic inputs on policing have to be given to the Police officials recruited under Sports Quota for a period of 3 months. During indoor training they will be given class on general matters relating to Kerala Police and Policing, after conducting the orientation course for the 7 days initially or 7 days from the beginning. The intention is to sensitise them to become police officials. The course/ schedule shall be designed day wise by the Principal PTC in consultation with the Central Sports Officer (CSO) and Joint CSO. This course/ schedule shall be approved by the State Police Chief.
2. During the 3 months training period, they will also be allowed to do their practices everyday in the morning and in the evening along with the other sports personnel.
3. One day will be meant for outdoor class to give exposure to the outdoor policing. They should be given basic inputs relating to parade, firing, police weapons etc.

4. From the 4th month onwards they will be attached to the CSO for continuous sports practice and this period will be considered as duty/ training for all purposes. During such period the CSO will conduct indoor classes on sports. He can take the help of the PTC and AP Bn. HQrs. and other institutions as deemed fit. This training will continue till the officials complete 9 months which will include 3 months of training at PTC.
5. Days lost due to attending of competitions/ camps/ sports training programmes etc. will also be treated as duty, before the completion of the 9 months training period. Examination shall be conducted by the Principal PTC in consultation with the CSO and once they successfully pass the examination their training should be declared as complete by the CSO and orders issued from the Battalion concerned. Then they will be attached to the respective battalions on paper but they will continue their sports activities like the existing sports personnel of Kerala police.
6. The objective is to ensure that immediately on the day of completion of 9 months of training, the training period is declared as complete so that they get financial benefits etc. as per the rules.
7. The above directions will come to effect immediately.
